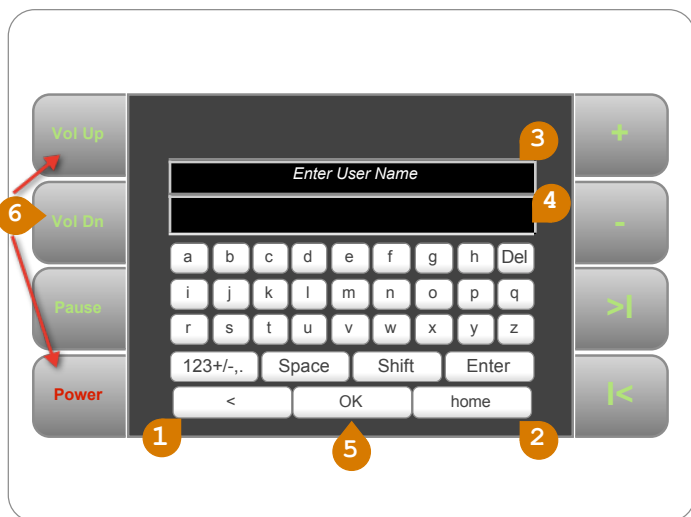


**Behavior Notes**

**User Path:** User has pressed the home button from any other screen or is presented upon initial power on state

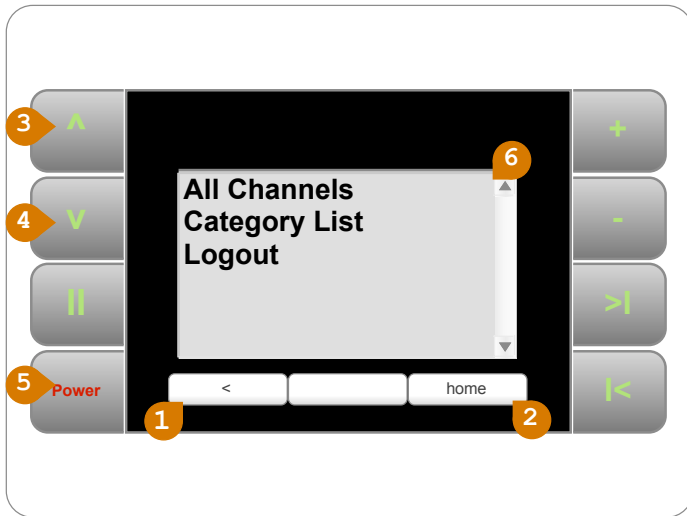
- 1 Takes the user to the favorites screen for selection
- 2 Source Select button labels are dynamically configured to the source name based on system settings. Press and release selects the associated source. For Streamer: If no prior mode has been selected, source selection goes to the streamer mode select menu. If a mode has been selected previously, source selection goes to the Now Playing screen for that mode.
- 3 Takes the user to the options screen



### Behavior Notes

**User Path:** User has selected SIRIUS from the Media Streamer mode selection menu for the first time or after logging out

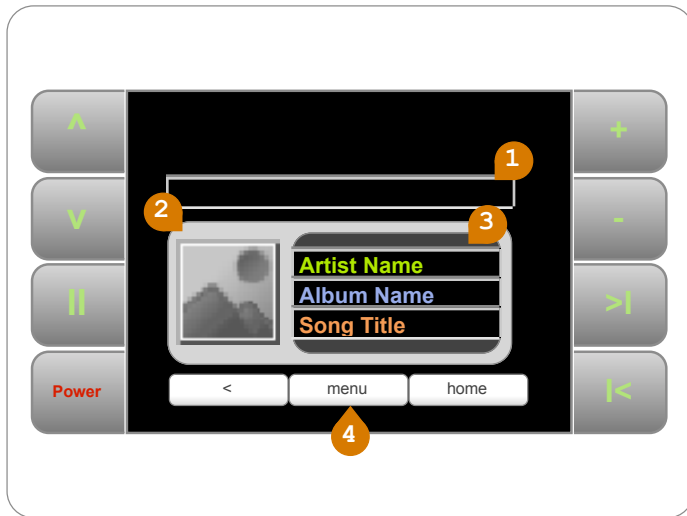
- 1 The back button returns the user to the SIRIUS Menu screen
- 2 The home button always returns navigation to the Home screen.
- 3 This field will be populated with the description of the text field entry requirement. By default this will state "Enter User Name". Upon pressing "Enter" or "OK" the user name is submitted and the help text field will state "Password". Upon pressing "Enter" or "OK" the password is submitted and the screen will return to SIRIUS Now Playing.
- 4 Credentials for SIRIUS Internet Radio requires credentials for each stream in that three streams will require three accounts where as one set of account credentials can be applied to any stream given that it is used for one stream at a time only.  
  
The desired use case would be to have the ability to store three sets of user account credentials which would not be directly tied to any given streaming module but that would "float" to be used when a streaming module is selected for streaming SIRIUS Internet Radio. If only one set of credentials is available and is being used, another stream will not be permitted to select SIRIUS and it would ideally be removed from the streamer mode list in this case. In this prototype the user name can be anything and the password must be "password" to be valid.
- 5 Pressing this button enters the user name or password credentials for authentication as required by SIRIUS and returns user to the SIRIUS Now Playing screen unless credentials are not valid in which a message is displayed on the information screen. Must comply with SIRIUS Minimum UI Requirements 9.1 and 9.8
- 6 Same functionality as when on Now Playing screen



### Behavior Notes

**User Path:** User has pressed the "menu" button on the SIRIUS "Now Playing" page

- 1 Press and release of the back button on the SIRIUS menu screen returns the user to the SIRIUS Now Playing Screen.
- 2 The home button always returns navigation to the Home screen.
- 3 Press and release increments the volume level by one value. Press and hold ramps the volume level up until released or maximum is reached.
- 4 Press and release decrements the volume level by one value. Press and hold ramps the volume level down until released or minimum is reached.
- 5 Press and release toggles the zone power on / off. Press and hold issues an all on or all off based on the present power state when issued.
- 6 Menu lists will revolve in a loop if possible. This will be most beneficial when users wish to go backwards to the 'end' of the list if it is shorter.



### Behavior Notes

**User Path:** User has selected Internet Radio from the Media Streamer mode selection menu

- 1 This field represents the source of the streaming content. This will be the internet radio station name or favorite name (if different). It tells the user where the content they are listening to is coming from.
- 2 Cover art (if available) will be placed in this location. Alternatively this location can be used for any logos or other graphic support deemed necessary or beneficial.
- 3 The artist name, album name, and song title (if available) will be displayed here for the content playing.
- 4 Selection of the Menu button takes the user to the vTuner Main Menu page for selection of list items
